

## **Zebra Cleaning Instructions**

For optimal performance and longevity, it is important to clean the vinyl on your Zebra products properly. Improper cleaning can destroy the vinyl on your Zebra products and can void your product warranty. Please read through all of these instructions regarding the cleaning of the vinyl on your Zebra products. - Do <u>not</u> use soap-based cleaners.
- Do <u>not</u> use bleach.
- Do <u>not</u> allow water to get behind the vinyl.
- Do <u>not</u> allow water to get under your Zebra mats. The bottom sides of the Zebra mats are not waterproof.
- Do <u>not</u> saturate the vinyl with water. It may not completely dry and may cause mold or mildew issues.
- We recommend cleaning and disinfecting with Zebra Enviro-Care Neutral Disinfectant cleaner.
- For large facilities or extremely high-traffic facilities, we recommend the Zebra Gym Scrubber. It professionally vacuums, scrubs, mops, and disinfects your entire gym all in one seamless operation. Please refer to the instructions that are included with the scrubber.
- Zebra cleaning instructions also apply to printed vinyl.

## **Daily Disinfecting Cleaning Instructions**

- 1. Remove loose debris from surface of the vinyl.
- 2. Mix the cleaning solution by adding 2 ounces of Zebra Enviro-care concentrate per gallon of water.
- 3. Apply the diluted solution to the vinyl with a cloth, mop, sponge, or spray bottle. Do not saturate the surface of the vinyl.
- 4. Let the solution air dry on the surface for a minimum of 10 minutes to kill or inactivate viruses. No rinsing is necessary. Allow vinyl to dry completely before use.

## **Special Decontamination Cleaning Instructions**

- 1. To clean blood or other bodily fluids from the vinyl, always follow universal precautions and use barrier protection (disposable gloves, protective clothing, face mask, and safety glasses) to prevent skin and mucous membrane contact with blood or other bodily fluids. All infectious materials must be disposed of according to federal, state, and local regulations for infections waste disposal.
- 2. After blood or other bodily fluids are thoroughly cleaned from surfaces, follow the daily disinfecting cleaning instructions above.

## **Deep Cleaning Instructions for Zebra Mats**

Use your best judgment on how often your mats should be deep cleaned. If you have several classes a day with high traffic on your mats or if you have considerable skin to mat contact, we suggest you do a deep clean more frequently.

- 1. If you will be using the same layout, we recommend taking a picture of the mat layout for a reference.
- 2. Remove the mats and take them to another area where they can be cleaned.
- 3. Sweep or vacuum the floor surface beneath the mats.
- 4. Clean and disinfect the floor surface beneath the mats and allow it to dry completely.
- 5. Using a vacuum hose, remove debris from the top, side edges, and bottom of the mats.
- 6. Mix the cleaning solution by adding 2 ounces of Zebra Enviro-care concentrate per gallon of water.
- 7. Apply the diluted solution to the vinyl with a cloth, mop, sponge, or spray bottle.
- 8. Using a medium bristle brush, scrub all of the vinyl surfaces of the mats, including the side edges and bottom edge.
- 9. The non-vinyl surface of the backside of the mats can be wiped clean. However, do not saturate the nonvinyl surface as it is not waterproof and the mats may become damaged if water soaks in.
- 10. Let the solution air dry on the surface for a minimum of 10 minutes to kill or inactivate viruses. No rinsing is necessary.
- 11. Allow the mats to dry completely before reinstalling them.
